

### **Draft Sightscreen Race “Playing Conditions”**

- The Charity Sponsored Sightscreen Race (the “Race”) shall be run on Thursday 1st August at the Cheam Road ground, at 20:00 BST, on a course designated by the Sutton CC organising committee (the “Organiser”) Sutton CC members and their guests, over the age of 15/School Year 9 at the time of the race, will be permitted to enter.
- Entries must be submitted by email to [krackal@suttoncricketclub.com](mailto:krackal@suttoncricketclub.com) and the deadline for Entries will be Midnight on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> July. Depending on the number of entrants, the Organiser reserves the right to arrange any number of qualifying rounds, as necessary, so as to determine a winner. There is no cost to enter but entrants are encouraged to seek sponsorship for the Teenage Cancer Trust:

- Each entry shall consist of two people (“Team”), who participate at their own risk. Each Team acknowledge that the Organiser has no liability for injury.
- Each Team shall designate one person as a runner (the “Runner”) and one person as a guide (the “Guide”). The Runner and Guide are not permitted to change.
- The Race shall consist of two parts: when the Organiser starts the race, the Runner must make 10 complete rotations around a stump at the start of the course, maintaining contact between the stump and their head for the duration, whilst not moving the stump from its original location (the “Stump”) After the completion of the Stump, the Runner must make their way across the finish line, approximately 100 yards from the start, guided by the Guide (the “Run”) The Guide is not permitted to make physical contact, either directly or indirectly, with the Runner during the Race and must direct the Runner with verbal instructions only.
- The Runner must remain blindfolded during the Race The winner shall be the first Team across the finish line, having completed the Stump and the Run
- The Organiser will have sole discretion for the implementation of the rules and determining the winner
